Community Solar Limited Power of Attorney & Assignment

1. Parties and Purpose

This Community Solar Limited Power of Attorney & Assignment (“Agreement”) is entered into by the undersigned individual or business entity receiving electric utility service (“Customer”). This Agreement authorizes limited actions solely in connection with Customer’s participation in community solar programs, including the listing of Customer information on a marketplace facilitating community solar enrollment and the assignment of enrollment rights to a qualified community solar provider.

2. Authorized Acquisition Partner

Customer acknowledges and agrees that Customer information may be collected and submitted by an Authorized Acquisition Partner, defined as any independent contractor, broker, marketer, representative, or entity approved by the GTB Solar Exchange platform solely for the purpose of submitting Customer information and obtaining Customer authorization through the platform’s intake system. GTB Marketing LLC d/b/a GTB Solar Exchange (“GTB”) is not an Authorized Acquisition Partner, is not granted authority under this Agreement, and does not act as Customer’s agent.

3. Limited Power of Attorney

Customer hereby grants the Authorized Acquisition Partner a limited power of attorney strictly limited to Customer’s participation in a community solar program. This authority includes collecting and submitting utility account information, listing Customer information on a marketplace facilitating community solar enrollment, communicating with community solar developers, subscription managers, and utilities solely to effectuate enrollment, and performing administrative actions necessary to complete and maintain such enrollment. Such authority expressly includes the ability to electronically execute community solar subscription agreements and related enrollment documents on Customer’s behalf solely for participation in a community solar project. This authority does not extend beyond community solar participation and is subject to the limitations set forth in this Agreement.

4. Assignment of Community Solar Enrollment Rights

Customer authorizes the Authorized Acquisition Partner to assign Customer’s community solar enrollment rights to a qualified community solar developer or subscription manager for the purpose of enrolling Customer into a community solar project, including through a third-party marketplace facilitating community solar transactions.

5. Explicit Exclusions

This Agreement does not authorize supplier switching, ESCO enrollment, rate plan changes, utility account ownership changes, or execution of contracts unrelated to community solar participation.

6. Electronic Authorization and Signature

Customer agrees that this Agreement may be executed electronically, including via checkbox consent and SMS confirmation, and that such electronic execution has the same legal effect as a handwritten signature under E-SIGN and UETA.

7. Records and Verification

Records of authorization may be retained electronically, including timestamps, phone numbers, utility account references, and copies of this Agreement as presented at the time of consent.

8. Term and Revocation

This Agreement remains effective until Customer's community solar participation is terminated or revoked in accordance with applicable program rules.

9. No Agency; Platform Neutrality

Customer acknowledges that GTB operates solely as a neutral technology and marketplace platform and does not act as an energy broker, marketer, consultant, developer, subscription manager, ESCO, or utility.

10. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state in which Customer's electric utility service account is located.
